BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. This ordinance shall extend for one (1) year from the date of its enactment Ordinance No. 0-17250, commonly known as the Single-Family Neighborhood Protection Ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
