ADOPTED ON JUL 31 1989

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 1,  
DIVISION 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY  
ADDING SECTION 31.0306 RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 1, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 31.0306, to read as follows:


**SEC. 31.0306 TAXES IMPOSED - ADDITIONAL SUM**

Effective September 1, 1989, there shall be added to the tax imposed by Section 31.0301 an additional sum of two dollars (\$2.00) each, for every employee covered in the computation of the tax imposed under the provisions of the first clause of Section 31.0301. This tax shall be collected on annual renewals or new applications after September 1, 1989.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on September 1, 1989 or on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, whichever is later.


