AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17305 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1989-90" TO CREATE THE NEW POSITION OF CHILD CARE COORDINATOR; EXEMPTING SAID NEW POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT "C" TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE SAID POSITION IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORY B; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, on June 19, 1989, the City Council authorized the establishment of a new position of Child Care Coordinator, to be funded out of Council's annual allocation for social services; and

WHEREAS, the Child Care Coordinator will plan, organize, coordinate, and participate in initiatives and strategies designed to increase the availability, accessibility, and affordability of quality child care services for City and private sector employees, as prescribed in the City's Child Care Policy (No. 300-12); and

WHEREAS, specific duties and responsibilities will include, but not be limited to the following: (1) maintain liaison and coordination with City departments, other governmental agencies, private sector developers, local employers, school districts, and other interested organizations and individuals for the purpose of facilitating the expansion of quality child care services within the City, (2) develop, implement, and maintain a comprehensive

Master Plan for Child Care for The City of San Diego, (3) research, prepare, and present written and oral reports on child care issues to the City Council, (4) analyze state and federal legislation and regulations pertaining to child care, and recommend appropriate actions to the City Council, and (5) assist in the establishment of a Child Care Advisory Board, and provide staff assistance to the Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is requesting that the position be established in the Unclassified Service and assigned to the Community Services Program; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed the justification for the position on July 6, 1989 and has commented favorably thereon; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to create said position if Council should deem it appropriate and establish an appropriate rate of compensation therefor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17305 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1989-90" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the position of CHILD CARE COORDINATOR.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably

by the Civil Service Commission on July 6, 1989 as meeting the Charter criterion for exemption from the Classified Service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Council deems exemption appropriate and the position created in section 1 above be and the same is hereby exempted from the Classified Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. O-17308 (NEW SERIES) be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designation of CHILD CARE COORDINATOR in in Managerial Category B.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated in sections 1 and 2 above, the position of CHILD CARE COORDINATOR is hereby authorized and at salary ranges of 07.3, 07.4, 07.5, and 07.6.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SUBJECT: Exemption of a new Child Care Coordinator Position from the
Classified Service

Only July 6, 1989, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Manager's Office to exempt a Child Care Coordinator position from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities to be performed, the Commission finds that this position meets the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.

This ordinance amends the annual salary ordinance by amending Exhibit "C" thereto by creating a new classification entitled, "CHILD CARE COORDINATOR." The ordinance also places said newly created classification in Managerial Category B of the unclassified service and establishes a salary rate of 07.3, 07.4, 07.5 and 07.6 for said new classification.


