8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m." and by renumbering Section 33.1406.1 to Sec-
tion 33.1406.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 33.1401 AND 33.1402, BY AMENDING AND RENUMBERING SECTION 33.14.07 TO READ SECTION 33.1406, BY ADDING SECTIONS 33.1407, 33.1408 AND 33.1409, AND BY AMENDING AND RENUMBERING SECTION 33.1406.1 TO READ SECTION 33.1410, AND BY RENUMBERING SECTION 33.1410 TO READ SECTION 33.1411 RELATING TO SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS AND INTERVIEWERS.

In addition to amending, renumbering and adding the above listed sections, this ordinance prohibits solicitation from the hours of 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. It also requires solicitors to observe posted residential notices which clearly deny invitation and entry to solicitors, e.g., "No Solicitors," "No Solicitation," "No Solicitors or Peddlers."
