AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 101.0462 RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT IN THE ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS OF THE CITY AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO LANDSCAPE TECHNICAL MANUAL.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0462, to read as follows:

SECTION 101.0462 RESOURCE PROTECTION ORDINANCE

A. RESOURCE PROTECTION PERMIT REQUIRED

Within the areas regulated by the provisions of the Resource Protection Ordinance no building, improvement or portion thereof shall be erected, constructed, converted, established, altered, enlarged, used, or demolished, nor shall any lot or premises be excavated or graded nor shall any vegetation be cleared and grubbed until a separate Resource Protection Permit is obtained in accordance with the procedures set forth in this section.

Resource Protection Permit shall not be required for installation of landscaping on preexisting single-family lots when grubbing, grading or other

development does not occur. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable pursuant to the provisions of Section 11.12 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

- F. DEFINITIONS

The following definitions shall apply only for the purposes of this section.

- 3. "Clearing" shall mean the cutting and removal of vegetation from the land without disturbance to the soil surface or destruction of the root system.
- 4. "Grubbing" shall mean the removal or destruction of vegetation by the removal of or disturbance to the root system and/or soil surface by any means including chemical.

- H. DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS
 - 1. and 2. [No change.]
 - 3. Floodplain Fringe
 - a. through d. [No change.]
- e. All development proposed in the floodplain fringe on property which borders the floodway, or is otherwise linked physically or visually with the floodway shall:

- 1) Provide not less than a twenty-five (25) foot-wide open space strip bordering the floodway, revegetated per Section 7.1 of the City of San Diego Landscape Technical Manual, on file in the office of the City Clerk.
 - 2) [No change.]
- f. All landscaping shall be in substantial conformance with the standards and specifications set forth in Chapter X, Division 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code (City-wide Landscaping Regulations) and the City of San Diego Landscape Technical Manual, on file in the office of the City Clerk.
- 4. Hillsides. Where a development is proposed on slopes of twenty-five percent (25%) grade and over, within the jurisdiction of the Resource Protection Overlay Zone as defined in Paragraph F. above the following regulations shall apply:
 - a. Hillsides shall be preserved in their natural state, provided a minimal encroachment into such slopes (areas disturbed by grading or development) may be permitted as set forth in the following table:

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, however, the provisions of this ordinance shall not be applicable within the Coastal Zone until the thirtieth day following the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment. If this ordinance is not certified, or is certified with suggested modifications by the California Coastal Commission, the provisions of this ordinance shall be null and void within the Coastal Zone.

Section 3. In areas of the City of San Diego other than the Coastal Zone no permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance.

Section 4. Within the Coastal Zone no permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certified this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 101.0462 RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT IN THE ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS OF THE CITY AMD THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO LANDSCAPE TECHNICAL MANUAL.

This ordinance amends Chapter X (Planning and Zoning Regulations) of the San Diego Municipal Code by amending various sections for maintenance and installation criteria of citywide land scapes. This updates existing standards, introduces new standards, and prioritizes and consolidates these standards. In addition, it updates definitions to be consistent with the new brush management and slope revegstion guidelines as recommended by the Land Development Advisory Board.
