AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 9.5, DIVISION 5, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 59.5.0502 AND 59.5.0601 RELATING TO THE DECLARATION OF CERTAIN ACTS CONSTITUTING DISTURBING, EXCESSIVE OR OFFENSIVE NOISES, AND THE PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 9.5, Division 5, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 59.5.0502 to read as follows:

# SEC. 59.5.0502 DISTURBING, EXCESSIVE, OFFENSIVE NOISES - DECLARATION OF CERTAIN ACTS CONSTITUTING

The following activities, among others, are declared to cause disturbing, excessive or offensive noises in violation of this section and are unlawful, namely:

A. Horns, Signaling Devices, Etc.

Unnecessary use or operation of horns, signaling devices, or other similar devices, on automobiles, motorcycles, or any other vehicle.

- B. Radios, Televisions Sets, Phonographs, Loud Speakers, Amplifiers and Similar Devices
  - 1. Uses Restricted.

The use or operation of any sound production or reproduction device, radio receiving set, musical

instrument, drum, phonograph, television set,
loudspeaker, sound amplifier or other similar machine or
device for the producing or reproducing of sound in such
a manner as to disturb the peace, quiet, or comfort of
any reasonable person of normal sensitivity in any area
of the City is prohibited. This provision shall not
apply to any participant in a licensed parade, or to any
person who has been otherwise duly authorized by The
City of San Diego to engage in such conduct.

#### 2. Prima Facie Violations

Any of the following shall constitute evidence of a prima facie violation of this section:

- (a) The operation of any such sound production or reproduction device, radio receiving set, musical instrument, drum, phonograph, television set, loud speaker and sound amplifier or similar machine or device between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. in such a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of fifty (50) feet from the building, structure, or vehicle in which it is located.
- (b) The operation of any sound amplifier, which is part of, or connected to, any radio, stereo receiver, compact disc player, cassette tape player, or other similar device when operated in such a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of fifty (50) feet and when operated in such a manner as to cause a person to

be aware of vibration accompanying the sound at a distance of fifty (50) feet from the source.

- 3. Enforcement of Prima Facie Violations
- (a) Any person who is authorized to enforce the provisions of this Article and who encounters evidence of a prima facie violation of this section is empowered to confiscate and impound as evidence, any or all of the components amplifying or transmitting the sound.
- (b) Any peace officer, as defined in Chapter 4.5 (commencing with Section 830) of the Penal Code, who encounters evidence of a prima facie violation of this section whereby the component(s) amplifying or transmitting the sound are attached to a vehicle may, in accordance with the provisions of California Vehicle Code section 22655.5, impound the vehicle, as containing evidence of a criminal offense, when the amplifying and/or transmitting component(s) cannot be readily removed from the vehicle without damaging the component(s) or the vehicle.
- C. Through F. (No changes.)

Section 2. That Chapter V, Article 9.5, Division 5, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 59.5.0601 to read as follows:

# SEC. 59.5.0601 VIOLATIONS: PENALTIES

Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not

exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or be imprisoned in the City or County jail for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.

Notwithstanding the above described penalties, following the conviction of a defendant for any prima facie violations of this article, the prosecutor may bring a motion requesting the court to order the destruction of any or all of the components amplifying or transmitting the sound.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This ordinance adds a new prima facle violation to the existing muisance noise provisions. The ordinance outlaws the operation of a cound device in such a way as to be heard and felt fifty (50) feet from withe source. Additionally, this ordinance increases the penalty for violation of nuisance noise provisions.
