ADOPTED ON NOV 21 1989

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17326 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1989-90 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17326-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY EXEMPTING A PRINCIPAL PLANNER POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; CAUSING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION SCHEDULE OF THE ENGINEERING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT (540), TRANSPORTATION DEMAND MANAGEMENT DIVISION, TO REFLECT THE PRINCIPAL PLANNER POSITION AS UNCLASSIFIED; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, on September 11, 1989, the City Council approved an administrative structure for the Mobility Planning Program, including one-half (0.5) Principal Planner position; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 1989, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-17355 amending the FY 1990 annual budget for the Engineering and Development Department and appropriating the necessary money to operate the Mobility Planning Program, and authorizing a new Transportation Demand Management Division to consist of 10.50 new positions, including 0.5 Principal Planner; and

WHEREAS, the Principal Planner will be responsible for a comprehensive land use planning effort with significant policy implications; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service commission reviewed the justification for exemption on September 7, 1989 and commented favorably thereon, as indicated in Attachment A hereto; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will exempt the new 0.5 Principal Planner position from the Classified Service; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on September 7, 1989, the new Principal Planner position in the Engineering and Development Department (540) Transportation Demand Management Division, be and it is hereby exempted from the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17326 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1989-90 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17326-1, as amended and adopted therein, by amending the personnel schedule for the Engineering and Development Department (540), Transportation Demand Management Division, to reflect the newly authorized Principal Planner position in the Unclassified Service.


Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for said Principal Planner position enumerated in sections 1 and 2 above, the position is placed in Managerial Category C, as set forth in Attachment C to Ordinance No. O-17308 (New Series) and established at salary ranges 07.7, 07.8 and 07.9.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two public hearings, pursuant

to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the
Charter of The City of San Diego.

SUBJECT: Exemption of a new Principal Planner Position From The
Classified Service

On September 7, 1989, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Engineering and Development Director to exempt a Principal Planner position from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities to be performed, the Commission finds that this position meets the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.


