AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17326 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1989-90 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17326-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY EXEMPTING ONE (1.00) PRINCIPAL PLANNER POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; CAUSING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION SCHEDULE OF THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT (065) TO REFLECT THE PRINCIPAL PLANNER POSITION AS UNCLASSIFIED; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, as part of the Planning Department's fiscal year 1990 budget, the City Council authorized a Principal Planner position with specified duties; and

WHEREAS, those duties include sufficient responsibilities for formulating and administering departmental policies and programs related to the Planned District Group; the Subdivision Maps and Review function and the Community Plan Implementing Legislation function; and

WHEREAS, this position will serve as a second level supervisor over a professional staff of two (2.00) Senior Planners and eight (8.00) Associate Planners; and

WHEREAS, this position has significant management level responsibilities which fall within the managerial definition contained in Charter section 117(a)17 and justify exemption from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the classified service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on October 5, 1989 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, this action will amend the appropriation ordinance to exempt the Principal Planner position from the classified service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on October 5, 1989, the Principal Planner position in the Planning Department (065), be and it is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17326 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1989-90 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17326-1, as amended and adopted therein, by making and reflecting such exemption from the classifies service of the Principal Planner

position in the personnel authorization schedule of the Planning Department (065).

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position recited in sections 1 and 2 hereof, funds appropriated and available therefor in the Planning Department, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.7, 7.8 and 7.9 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-17305 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

This ordinance amends the annual appropriation ordinance by amending the personnel authorization schedule of the Planning Department (065) by exempting one (1.00) Principal Planner position from the classified service and declaring it to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego and establishes a rate of pay for said position.


