A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION R-271066 AND ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE OLD BLACK MOUNTAIN ROAD, AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That Resolution No. R-271066, a previously approved resolution of intention to close the dirt portion of Old Black Mountain Road from Via Abertura to Donaker Street, be and is hereby rescinded.

2. That the public interest and convenience of said City may require the temporary closure of a portion of the street, hereinafter mentioned.


3. That it is the intention of said Council to order the temporary closure of Old Black Mountain Road, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. A-1 on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 271066, for a period of time estimated to be in excess of one (1) year.

4. That this Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said temporary closure under the provisions of the "Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law." California Streets and Highways Code section 8300 et seq.

5. That this Council hereby fixes 10:00 a.m. on June 13, 1989, in the Council Chambers on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed temporary closure.

6. That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.


