RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, CONFIRMING THE ASSESSMENT, ORDERING THE IMPROVEMENTS MADE, TOGETHER WITH APPURTENANCES, AND APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S "REPORT"

(Assessment District No. 4011 [De La Fuente, Business Park, Phase I])

WHEREAS, the CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, did, on the 23rd day of January, 1989, adopt its Resolution of Intention for the acquisition of certain public works of improvement, together with appurtenances and appurtenant work, in a special assessment district known and designated as ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 4011 (DE LA FUENTE BUSINESS PARK, PHASE I) (hereinafter referred to as the "Assessment District"); and,

WHEREAS, this legislative body is further desirous to accept the works of improvement as installed and subject to acquisition under these proceedings; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Resolution of Intention, a "Report", as therein provided, was presented, considered and approved; and,

WHEREAS, said "Report", as preliminarily approved, contained all the matters and items called for by law and as pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913", being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, including the following:

- 1. Estimate of cost;
- 2. Diagram of Assessment District;
- 3. An assessment according to benefits;
- 4. A description of the works of improvement to be acquired; and,

WHEREAS, all protests have been heard and considered and a full hearing has been given, all in the manner provided by law; and,
