RESOLUTION NUMBER R-272998 ADOPTED ON MAR 6 1989

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the Environmental License Plate Program (ELP), providing funds to the state and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and for developing facilities for public recreation and historical purposes; and

WHEREAS, the California State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility for administering the program within the state and setting up the necessary procedures governing applications by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require applicant agencies to certify by resolution the approval of applications prior to submission of said applications to the state; and

WHEREAS, said applications contain assurances with which the applicant must comply; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego wishes to secure funds under the ELP Program in the amount of \$500,000 for the development of Mission Bay Park-Shoreline Protection and Water Quality Enhancement and in the amount of \$500,000 for the acquisition of Famosa Slough; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the filing of applications for ELP grant assistance be and the

same is hereby certified for the Mission Bay Park-Shoreline Protection Development and the Famosa Slough Acquisition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies that it understands the assurances and certification in the applications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Council certifies that it has reviewed and understands the General Provisions contained in the state/local agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 272998.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies that The City of San Diego has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain said projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager or his representative, as agent for the City, is authorized to conduct all negotiations and to submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payments requested and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a special interest-earning fund for each project, if funded.
