RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA
PRELIMINARILY APPROVING REPORT OF
SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS AND FIXING TIME AND
PLACE OF HEARING THEREON.

Assessment District No. 4029

Sorrento Valley Road-Sorrento Valley Boulevard to I-805

WHEREAS, this Council has heretofore adopted its Resolution of Intention, Resolution No. R- 273086, declaring its intention to acquire and construct certain street improvement work (the "Project") within proposed Assessment District No. 4029, under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Council, in said Resolution No. R- 273086, directed the Superintendent of Streets to procure the required information and prepare and present to the City Council a written report on the project required by said Municipal Improvement Act of 1913; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets has prepared such report and presented it to this City Council on this date; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Preliminary Approval of Report. Said report be and the same hereby is preliminarily approved, and the City Clerk is directed forthwith to endorse the fact and date of such approval on said report and to file said report in the City Clerk's Office.

2. Time and Place of Hearing. THAT THE 2ND DAY OF MAY, 1989, AT THE HOUR OF 10:00 A.M. IN THE CITY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, 202 "C" STREET, 12TH FLOOR, COUNCIL CHAMBERS, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, IS HEREBY FIXED AS THE TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING ON SAID APPROVED REPORT, AND SUCH HEARING SHALL BE HELD BY THIS CITY COUNCIL.

3. Publication of Notice. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause a notice of such hearing to be published once a week for two (2) successive weeks, the first publication to be made at least twenty (20) days before the date set for hearing of protests. The San Diego Daily Transcript, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego, is hereby selected as the newspaper in which notice of such hearing shall be published.


4. Mailing of Notice. The City Clerk is hereby further directed to cause notices of such hearing to be mailed at least twenty (20) days prior to such hearing as provided in said Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, postage prepaid, to all persons whose property is proposed to be assessed to pay any part of the cost of the project, whose names and addresses appear on the last equalized assessment roll or as known to the City Clerk.

5. Posting of Notice. The Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be conspicuously posted on all open streets within the proposed Assessment District No. 4029, at not more than 300 feet apart on each street so posted, but not less than three in all, except that in the case where there are no such open streets, such notices shall be posted in three conspicuous places within said Assessment District No. 4029.

6. Simultaneous Hearing and Notice Regarding Majority Protest Act. That the hearing on whether public necessity and convenience require the project and whether the provisions of the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and section 19, article XVI of the California Constitution shall apply to the project shall be held at the same time and place as the hearing on the written report of the Superintendent of Streets set forth herein, and notice of such hearing by publication and posting shall be given at the same time and in the same manner as notice of the hearing on said written report.

7. Repeal of Inconsistent Resolution. Any resolution of the City and any part of such resolution inconsistent with this resolution is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
