RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR SEALED PROPOSALS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS.

Assessment District No. 4029

Sorrento Valley Road-Sorrento Valley Boulevard to I-805

WHEREAS, this Council has adopted its Resolution of Intention, Resolution No. R-273086, on March 20, 1989, declaring its intention to order the construction of certain street improvements, appurtenances and appurtenant work as more particularly described and set forth in said resolution (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets has duly prepared and presented a written report on the project in the form and manner required by the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that bids for the project be taken at such time as specified herein; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. <u>Publication of Notice Inviting Bids</u>. That the Purchasing Agent for The City of San Diego is hereby directed to publish

once a week for two weeks in the San Diego Daily Transcript, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego, a notice inviting sealed proposals or bids for the construction of the project and referring to the plans and specification on file in the Office of the City Clerk, the first publication of such notice to be at least fourteen (14) days prior to the time fixed for the opening of bids.

- 2. <u>Deposits With Bids</u>. Said notice shall require that all proposals or bids shall be accompanied by cash, a cashier's check or a certified check payable to the order of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid, or by a bond in said amount and so payable to the satisfaction and approval of the Superintendent of Streets. The amounts so posted shall be forfeited to the City in case the bidder depositing the same does not, within fifteen (15) days after written notice that the contract has been awarded to said bidder, enter into a contract with the City for the work.
- 3. Time and Place of Opening Bids. Said sealed proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Purchasing Agent, City of San Diego, 1010 Second Avenue, San Diego, California, 92101, on or before 11:00 o'clock A.M. on the 25TH day of APRIL , 1989, at which time said bids will be publicly opened, examined and declared. Said bids will be referred to and considered by this Council at its meeting at 10:00 o'clock A.M. on MAY 2 , 1989.

4. Repeal of Inconsistent Resolution. Any resolution of the City and any part of such resolution inconsistent with this resolution is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
