RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO DE-ANNEX AND
RE-ANNEX PORTIONS OF THE OCEAN BEACH LANDSCAPE
AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council proposes and intends to de-annex portions of the Ocean Beach Lighting and Landscape District No. 1, such areas to be included within the Newport/Santa Monica Avenue Lighting District upon the formation of said district, in said City under the provisions of the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975, sections 65.0201 through 65.0220 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, California Streets and Highways Code section 22500 et seq.

Section 1

DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY TO BE DE-ANNEXED

All that real property in said City of San Diego included within the area described as "to be de-annexed from existing Ocean Beach Street Lighting District No. 1 on the map designated as the "Newport Avenue/Santa Monica Avenue Street Light Maintenance District" consisting of one (1) page and filed in the office of the City Clerk under Document No. M-202-2, excepting therefrom all public streets, public lands, roads, alleys, avenues and highways. Reference is hereby made to the map for a further full and more particular description of the

area to be de-annexed on the map, so on file, shall govern for all details as to the extent of the area of de-annexation.

Section 2

TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 6th of June, 1989, at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in the City of San Diego, California, is the day, hour and place for the hearing when any person interested may object to the proposed de-annexation pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 22606(b) these proceedings shall be consolidated with the hearing on the formation of the Newport/Santa Monica Avenue Lighting District and adoption of this resolution is contingent upon creation of the new district. Failure to make objections at the time of the consolidation hearing will be deemed to be a waiver of all objections and shall operate as a bar for any claim for damages. Such protest, if any, must be in writing and must contain a description of the property in which each signer thereof is interested, sufficient to identify the same and shall be delivered to and filed with the City Clerk at a time no later than the hour set for the hearing.


