



SCHEDULE OF REFUSE DISPOSAL FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1990

AUTHORITY - The following Refuse Disposal Fees have been established by Council Resolution R-273425 on May 8, 1989 in accordance with the City of San Diego Municipal Code, Chapter VI, Article 6, Section 66.0125 as revised by Ordinance 17304 on May 22, 1989.

1. DISPOSAL FEES

The standard fee for the disposal of residential, commercial, and/or industrial waste collected within the corporate limits of the City of San Diego is \$15.00 PER TON EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1989.

Fees shall be collected based upon the actual weight of waste delivered to the refuse disposal facility. However, if actual weights are uncertain or not available, the flat rate fees described herein will be applicable

A. REFUSE COLLECTION VEHICLES

Mechanical packers will be charged \$15.00 per ton for the actual net payload of the vehicle, except that City packers and City-licensed packers shall receive a \$2.00 discount on all refuse collected wholly within the corporate limits of the City of San Diego. In the event the scales or computerized registers are not operable FEES WILL BE CHARGED ON THE CALCULATED LEGAL NET PAYLOAD FOR EACH LICENSED PACKER UNDER ESTABLISHED STATE OF CALIFORNIA WEIGHT LIMITS.

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THE DISPOSAL FEE FOR NON-CITY WASTE, I.E. ANY PORTION OF THE LOAD WAS GENERATED OUTSIDE OF THE CITY LIMITS, WILL BE THE HIGHER OF THE CITY FEE OR THE COUNTY DISPOSAL FEE FOR THE APPLICABLE CLASS OF VEHICLE.

2. SPECIAL HANDLING FEES

Additional charges shall be assessed for all waste materials requiring special disposal techniques or a Disposal Site Representative to oversee disposal operations. Such items shall include, but not be limited to, dead animals, loads of items containing steel wire or springs such as mattresses and car seats, portions of boats, auto and truck bodies, straw or similar materials, certified non-infectious medical waste, and any load of large (1 cubic foot or more) dense items. Special handling charges shall be in addition to all other disposal fees and shall be \$15.00 for passenger cars, pickups, and small trailers, and \$30.00 for all larger vehicles, except for the following specific items:

1. Request for burial of a load \$ 30.00
in the presence of the facility user.
 2. Any tree stump more than 3 foot 15.00 ea
in any linear dimension.
- Not to exceed a maximum surcharge of: 100.00

3. Any single item or animal which due to its size, weight, volume, or other physical characteristics requires special handling and/or equipment, or presents a significant health, safety, or operational problem 50.00 ea

4. Any dead animal(s) or fowl(s)
 - a. in excess of 250 pounds 30.00 e
 - b. less than 250 pounds 15.00 ea
 - c. loads of dead animals with a total weight in excess of 500 pounds 30.00

5. Kelp residue or similar waste \$6.00 cu yd

6. Containerized solid industrial waste
 1. Five (5) gallon 5.00ea
 2. Twenty-five (25) gallon 10.00ea
 3. Fifty-five (55) gallon 25.00ea

7. Any load containing more than ten (10) cubic yards of straw, car seats, mattresses, or other similar hard-to-handle material 30.00

8. Any load containing poles, pipes, tree trunks, logs, bridge pilings, more than ten (10) feet long, and/or more than 12 inches in diameter: 15.00 ea
Maximum surcharge not to exceed: 100.00
9. Any load with standard car or truck tires (not to exceed 22 inches in wheel diameter).
- a. five or less NO CHARGE
 - b. more than five (5) .50 ea
 - c. construction type or heavy industrial tires 25.00 ea
10. Certified non-infectious waste: 30.00
11. Certification of disposal of contaminated soil 30.00
12. Any appliance more than two (2) feet in any linear dimension: 3.00 ea
If returned to Recycling Center NO CHARGE

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MONTGOMERY LANDFILL FEES

Montgomery Landfill can only accept inert materials such as earth, rock, concrete, asphalt paving materials, clay products, and inert slage and tailings delivered in self-dumping vehicles. Oversize demolition materials will be subject to a special handling fee in accordance with Section 2 above.

Fees for qualifying inert demolition materials are:

Trailers over 12 feet in length:	\$ 25.00
Two axle trucks	25.00
Three axle trucks	75.00
Three axle trucks with trailers	100.00
Semi-tractor & trailer combinations	100.00
