In the event the scales or computerized registers are not operable FEES WILL BE CHARGED ON THE CALCULATED LEGAL NET PAYLOAD FOR EACH LICENSED PACKER UNDER ESTABLISHED STATE OF CALIFORNIA WEIGHT LIMITS.
