BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND STREET LIGHTING SYSTEM AT CAMINO RUIZ AND CAPRICORN WAY/TERESA DRIVE, San Diego, California, filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San Diego, California, on OCT 16 1989, and bearing official Document No. W.O. 119299, be and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Agent of the City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids for the work hereinabove described, in accordance with the plans and specifications hereinabove referred to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND STREET LIGHTING SYSTEM AT CAMINO RUIZ AND CAPRICORN WAY/TERESA DRIVE.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized, if circumstance warrant, to finance or refinance this project with tax exempt securities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditors and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$31,500 from Trust Fund 63021 to Trust Fund 63022, CIP No. 61-001, ANNUAL ALLOCATION - SIGNAL INSTALLATIONS TO ACCOMMODATE SUDDEN TRAFFIC CHANGES.
