RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 274699

ADOPTED ON NOV131989

WHEREAS, Earth Day 1990 will commemorate the 20th anniversary of a global demonstration of citizen concern for the protection of planet Earth; and

WHEREAS, twenty years ago, the United States Congress adjourned for Earth Day and celebrated in their home districts along with ten thousand school, two thousand colleges and universities, and thousands of community groups; and

WHEREAS, the original Earth Day helped prompt the passage of the Clean Air Act, the Clean Water Act and the creation of the Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, twenty years later, the Earth remains at risk from global warming, acid rain, ozone depletion, rain forest destruction, and other environmental problems; and

WHEREAS, Earth Day 1990 will be the product of a coalition reaching beyond existing environmental constituencies to involve the broadest possible cross-section of society including business, media, religious, political, labor, academic and cultural leaders; and

WHEREAS, cities can and must make major contributions to solving our environmental and natural resource problems through land use, transportation, solid waste, wastewater treatment, building codes decisions that shape our environment; and

WHEREAS, local governments currently operate numerous ridesharing, recycling, energy and water conservation, and hazardous waste programs that depend on widespread and understanding and participation in order to be successful; and

WHEREAS, the Global Cities Program is a program created and managed by Earth Day 1990 that will provide member cities with specific programmatic support through program development seminars, a project planning guide, a newsletter, access to a technical assistance exchange referral service and a final report of the Global Cities Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that April 22, 1990 be observed as Earth Day in San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to establish an account to accept private donations that will offset the entire membership fee of \$2,000 for The City of San Diego's enrollment in the Global Cities Project.
