Keller, Attorney, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in approving La Jolla Shores Permit No. 89-0384 submitted by Brian Malk, Owner/Permittee, for the purpose of constructing a 3,363 square foot single-family residence, located at 7975 St. Louis Terrace, on the north side of St. Louis Terrace between Spindrift and Hypatia, in the La Jolla Shores Community Plan area, in a single-family zone; and

1. The proposed development will not encroach upon existing physical accessway legally utilized by the public or any proposed public accessway identified in an adopted Coastal Program Land Use Plan; it will obstruct views to and along the ocean and other scenic coastal areas from public vantage points.

- 2. The proposed development will not adversely affect marine resources, environmentally sensitive areas, and archaeological or paleontological resources.
- 3. The proposed development will not adversely affect recreational and visitor-serving facilities and coastal scenic resources.
- 4. The proposed development is sited and designed to prevent adverse impacts to environmentally sensitive habitats and scenic resources located in adjacent parks and recreation areas, and will provide adequate buffer areas to protect such resources.
- 5. The proposed development will minimize the alterations of natural landforms and will not result in undue risks from geological and erosional forces and/or flood and fire hazards.
- 6. The proposed development will not be visually compatible with the character of surrounding areas, and will not restore and enhance the visual quality in visually degraded areas.
- 7. The proposed development does not conform with the General Plan, the Local Coastal Program, and the La Jolla Shores Community Plan.

The above findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed development does not comply with the La Jolla Architectural Design Manual.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of Lawrence Haber, et al., by Lawrence R. Keller, Attorney, is granted; the decision of the Planning Commission is overruled, and La Jolla Shores Permit No. 89-0384 is hereby denied.
