RESOLUTION NUMBER R-275054 ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 12, 1989

WHEREAS, on November 20, 1989, the City Council, pursuant to Municipal Code section 101.0240, voted to hear the appeal of a Board of Zoning Appeals' decision granting William P. Shannahan Conditional Use Permit No. 19499; and,

WHEREAS, on December 4, 1989, the City Council unanimously voted to reconsider their vote of November 20, 1989; and,

WHEREAS, on December 12, 1989, the City Council, pursuant to their vote of December 4, 1989, and Municipal Code section 101.0240, did reconsider whether to hear the appeal of a Board of Zoning Appeals' decision granting William P. Shannahan Conditional Use Permit No. 19499; and,

WHEREAS, in arriving at their decision on December 12, 1989, the City Council considered the Report of the Planning Department, the minutes of the prior hearings of the Board of Zoning Appeals and the Zoning Administrator, and the decisions of both the Board of Zoning Appeals and the Zoning Administrator; and,

WHEREAS, in arriving at their decision on December 12, 1989, the City Council relied on the record of the proceedings before the Board of Zoning Appeals and the written appeal; and,

WHEREAS, on December 12, 1989, the City Council found:

^{1.} To allow guest quarters in a singlefamily residential neighborhood may change the character of the neighborhood; and,

- 2. There are situations where guest quarters should be allowed because the character of the neighborhood would not be adversely affected or because to deny the guest quarters would be an unfairness to the land owner; and,
- 3. The City Council considers this issue to be so important to each of the neighborhoods in the City that the City Council must have the ability to make the final decision about where guest quarters are to be allowed; and,
- 4. The development that is proposed by Mr. Shannahan, that is, the building of maid's quarters on top of a detached accessory structure, presents a City-wide planning issue: should single-family residential neighborhoods be allowed to change to accommodate this two-on-one type of development? and,
- 5. Guidance of the City Council is required on this issue because the concerns of all of San Diego must be brought to bear on the planning process; and,
- 6. The matter presented by the appeal of the Board of Zoning Appeals decision granting William P. Shannahan Conditional Use Permit No. 19499 is of City-wide significance because when guest quarters are added to a single-family residential lot a neighborhood's character may be changed, sending a signal to all neighborhoods that their neighborhoods may be changed;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego,
That, having made the findings required by Municipal Code
section 101.0240, the appeal of the Board of Zoning Appeals'
decision granting William P. Shannahan Conditional Use Permit No.
19499 shall be heard by the City Council.
