AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 1,
DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 31.0120 RELATING TO
BUSINESS TAXES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 31.0120, to read as follows:

SEC. 31.0120 UNLAWFUL BUSINESS PRACTICES


(a) No certificate issued under the provisions of this Article shall be construed to authorize the conduct or continuance of any illegal or unlawful business or of any business for which a license or permit is required by state law, county ordinance, or the San Diego Municipal Code, including but not limited to police, zoning, planning, building or engineering permits, or state contractor's licenses and the like. The issuance of a business tax certificate shall not relieve an owner or operator from obtaining any licenses or permits that are necessary under other provisions of law for employees or for operation of the business.

(b) It is unlawful to use or refer to a business tax certificate issued under the provisions of this Article in any advertisement, or to present or represent such certificate as a license or permit which is required by other provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code or the laws of the State of California, or the County of San Diego.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 31.0120 UNLAWFUL BUSINESS PRACTICES

(a) No certificate issued under the provisions of this Article shall be construed to authorize the conduct or continuance of any illegal or unlawful business, or of any business for which a license or permit is required to be issued by statute or other provisions of by state law, county ordinance or the San Diego Municipal Code, including but not limited to police, or health, permits, zoning, permits, planning, permits, building or engineering permits, or state contractors licenses and the like. The issuance of a business tax certificate shall not relieve ~~the~~ an owner or operator from obtaining any licenses or permits that are necessary under other provisions of law for employees or for operation of the business.

(b) It is unlawful to use or refer to a business tax certificate issued under the provisions of this Article in any advertisement, or to present or represent

such certificate as a license or permit which is
required by other provisions of the San Diego Municipal
Code or the laws of the State of California or the
County of San Diego.


