AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PARKING METER ZONE ON BOTH SIDES OF UNIVERSITY AVENUE BETWEEN FIRST AVENUE AND THIRD AVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority of Section 22508 of the California Vehicle Code and in accordance with the provisions of Section 86.11 of the San Diego Municipal Code, a parking meter zone is hereby established on both sides of University Avenue between First Avenue and Third Avenue. The above described meters shall be in parking meter Zone A as described in Section 86.13 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. A parking time limit of two hours shall be in effect in the above described location between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Sundays and certain holidays excepted, as provided in Section 86.16 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 3. The installation of parking meters and the necessary signs and markings be, and the same is hereby authorized to be made in the above described location.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 5, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 103.0526.16 RELATING TO THE MISSION BEACH PLANNED DISTRICT PARKING REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as

follows:
Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 3, Division 5, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending
Section 103.0526.18, to read as follows:
A, and B. (No change.)
C. Parking shall not be permitted in required yards other than inte-

C. Parking shall not be permitted in required yards other than inter-rior or rear yards, except as provided herein.

1. For properlies where any legal development, redevelopment or improvement that created or enlarged floor area on the premises oc-curred between February 27, 1964, and February 1, 1979, and the yard was being used for parking on or before February 1, 1979, parking shall be permitted within yards abutting courts, places, or Mission Boulevard provided that:

7. a. Sald area shall not be utilized to satisfy off-street parking re-quired under this Division.

quired under this Division.

b: Said area shall not be utilized by any vehicle that exceeds 6' in height when measured vertically from the highest point of the vehicle to the parking surface.

c. A minimum of 25% of all required yards, except interior and rear, yards, shall be landscaped with a combination of trees, shrubs and ground cover in conformance with standards adopted by the Planning Commission as set forth in the document entitled, "City of San Diego Landscape Technical Manual," on file in the office of the City Clerk.

3'd. For yards abutting courts or places and for parking adjacent to and parallel to Mission Boulevard:

(1) 3' high wall or fence shall be located between the parking area and the sidewalk.

(2) Sald wall or fence may be located within the public right-of-way if an encroachment permit is obtained.

(3) (No change in text.)

2. For properties developed prior to February 27, 1964, parking shall be permitted within yards abutting courts, places, or Mission Boulevard, and are not required to provide additional landscaping of the fencing separation, provided said property is in compliance with permits or regulations in effect at the time the property was developed.

D. through G. (No change.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment. If this ordinance is not certified, or is certified with suggested modifications by the California Coastal Commission, the provisions of this ordinance shall be null and void.

Section 3. No permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certified this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment.
