AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII, ARTICLE 6, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 86.27 RELATING TO PARKING OF HEAVY DUTY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VIII, Article 6, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 86.27 to read as follows:

## SEC. 86.27 PARKING OF HEAVY DUTY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS

No person shall park any heavy duty commercial vehicle on a street in any residential district except (a) while loading or unloading property, or (b) when such vehicle is parked in connection with, and in aid of, the performance of a service to or on a property in the block in which such vehicle is parked, or (c) such vehicle is parked immediately in front of or along side of premises actively devoted to industry or commerce and lying contiguous to the street.

For the purpose of this section, certain terms shall be defined as follows:

- 1. Heavy duty commercial vehicle shall mean a commercial vehicle having a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of 10,000 pounds or more.
- 2. Residential district shall mean any district zoned residential in accordance with the zoning definitions established in Chapter X of the Municipal Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This Ordinance revises San Diego Municipal Code section 88.27 to This Ordinance revises San Diego Municipal Code section 88.27 to incorporate changes required by a recent opinion of the California Attorney General. All references to other than commercial vehicles are removed. The wleight limit is established at 10,000 pounds Gross Vehicle Weight rating and the term Residential District is defined by reference to Chapter X of the San Diego Municipal Code. The three hour duration for parking nonconforming vehicles is removed.
