ADOPTED ON JUN 11 1990

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PENAL CODE  
REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE SELECTION AND  
TRAINING STANDARDS OF PUBLIC SAFETY  
DISPATCHERS.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego desires that the San Diego Police Department participate in the Public Safety Dispatcher Program; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego will incur no costs as a result of the San Diego Police Department's participation in the Public Safety Dispatcher Program; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego would be eligible to receive yearly reimbursement from the Peace Officers' Training Fund estimated at fifteen thousand, seven hundred and fifty-six dollars (\$15,756.00) for San Diego Police Department's participation in the Public Safety Dispatcher Program; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego desires to qualify for aid from the Peace Officers' Training Fund created and appropriated exclusively pursuant to California Penal Code section 13520 for costs of administration and grants to local governments and districts; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego must by ordinance, as specifically required by California Penal Code section 13522, pledge that the San Diego Police Department will adhere to standards for recruitment and training established by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training

(POST) pursuant to the provisions of California Penal Code section 13510(c) to qualify for state aid under the Safety Dispatcher Training Program; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. The City of San Diego declares that it desires to qualify to receive aid from the State of California under the provisions of Section 13522, Chapter 1, of Title 4, Part 4, of the California Penal Code.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 13510(c), Chapter 1, the San Diego Police Department will adhere to standards for recruitment and training established by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 13512, Chapter 1, the Commission and its representatives may make such inquiries as deemed appropriate by the Commission to ascertain that the San Diego Police Department's public safety dispatcher personnel adhere to standards for selection and training established by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PENAL CODE REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE SELECTION AND TRAINING STANDARDS OF PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHERS.**

California Penal Code section 13510 requires the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) to establish minimum selection and training standards for public safety dispatchers. The San Diego Police Department currently adheres to those standards. This ordinance pledges continued adherence to POST standards so the San Diego Police Department can participate in the Public Safety Dispatcher Program.

The San Diego Police Department must submit a copy of an ordinance which pledges adherence to standards adopted by the Commission to participate in the Public Safety Dispatcher Program and to be eligible for reimbursement of certain dispatcher training costs.
