AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17326 (NEW SERIES), ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1989-90 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY MODIFYING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM TO INCREASE THE FY 1990 BUDGET OF CIP NO. 21-836, BALBOA PARK FIRE ALARM BUILDING - RENOVATION, BY \$282,455 AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$50,000 FROM CAPITAL OUTLAY FLORIDA CANYON FUND NO. 30245.1 AND \$232,455 FROM CIP NO. 21-834.0 BALBOA PARK REQUIREMENTS, CAPITAL OUTLAY - OTHER REVENUE FUND NO. 32453 TO CIP NO. 21-836, BALBOA PARK FIRE ALARM BUILDING - RENOVATION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-17326, (New Series), as amended, entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 1989-1990 and Appropriating the Necessary Money to Operate the City for Said Fiscal Year" is hereby amended to modify the Capital Improvement Program to increase the FY 1990 budget of CIP No. 21-836, entitled BALBOA PARK FIRE ALARM BUILDING - RENOVATION, by \$282,455.00.

Section 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$50,000 from Capital Outlay Florida Canyon Fund No. 30245.1, and \$232,455 from CIP No. 21-834.0, BALBOA PARK REQUIREMENTS, CAPITAL OUTLAY - Other Revenue Fund No. 32453 to CIP No. 21-836, BALBOA PARK FIRE ALARM BUILDING - RENOVATION.

Section 3. That the expenditure, not to exceed \$436,000 from CIP No. 21-836, BALBOA PARK FIRE ALARM BUILDING - RENOVATION, is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for providing funds for said project and related costs.

Section 4. That the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

## ORDINANCE NO. 0-17515 (New Series)

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATES AND LEVYING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-01.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATES AND LEVYING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91.

WHEREAS, Section 75 of the Charter of the City of San Diego requires an annual tax levy be adopted by ordinance not later than the list day of August of each year; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 13 approved by the voters to be effective July 1, 1978 amended the State Constitution by adding Article XIIIA to limit the amount of advalorem tax on real property; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Article XIIIA and the adoption of state legislation in concurrence thereto, the Charter provissions related to amount of tax and process of collection have been modified and superseded; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XIIIA and the accompanying state legislation, the annual tax levy is limited to those certain exceptions provided for in said Article XIIIA and Section 2337, and 2237.1 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above recited provisions of law, it is required that the County of San Diego levy the annual advalorem property tax, on the full value of said property, except as otherwise provided therein, and distribute it to the public agencies and districts within the County; NOWTHEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:
Section 1, Pursuant to the provisions of Section 75 of the Charter of the City of San Diego, Article XIIIA of the State Constitution and the state legislation adopted pursuant thereto, there is hereby fixed a rate of taxation of nine and eight one-hundredths mills (0.00908) on each one hundred dollars' valuation of taxable property (full value) within the City of San Diego for the fiscal year 1990-91 and that the rate is never the county of san Diego for the fiscal year 1990-91 and that the rate is section 77a of said Charter.

Section 2. An allowance of five percent (5.0%) for anticipated deliquencies in tax payments upon real property and improvements thereon and personal property secured, other than properties of public utilities, is hereby established.

(1) Section 77a of the City Charter requires a two-cent tax levy on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation. Section 135 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code now defines "assessed value" as full value. Pursuant to Section 135(d) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code a conversion factor of one-fourth (¼) is applied to the tax rate for purposes of expressing tax rates on the same basis. This rate will be applied to taxable property assessed at full value (100%) for FY 1990-91.

Section 4. The taxes hereby levied shall be due and payable and shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as State and County taxes in the County of San Diego.

Section 5. This ordinance is declared to take effect immediately upon its passage, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 15 and 17 of the Charter of the City of San Diego.
