

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 17517 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON AUG 27 1990

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE DISTRICTS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 15370 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED OCTOBER 27, 1980.

WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council, Council District 3 recommended to the full Council a redistricting map for approval and adoption; and

WHEREAS, that map has been duly amended at the special meeting of the City Council on August 13, 1990, as more particularly shown on the map designated as Map No. 20 which was, pursuant to the settlement agreement in the case of Perez, et al. v. City of San Diego, et al., duly furnished to the representatives of the class and all other interested parties on or about August 9, 1990; and

WHEREAS, Map No. 20 is appended hereto and fully incorporated herein by this reference; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That boundary lines of the eight districts of The City of San Diego, for the purpose of electing members of the Council, are hereby established, as more particularly shown and delineated on a map showing boundary lines of the districts on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-17517,

which is, by this reference, fully incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. The offices of the Council members elected from even-numbered councilmanic districts shall be regularly up for election every four years commencing in 1991. The offices of Council members elected from odd-numbered councilmanic districts shall be regularly up for election every four years commencing in 1993.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 15370 (New Series), adopted October 27, 1980, is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
