AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17504 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17504-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT (120) TO DELETE ONE (1.00) BATTALION CHIEF POSITION AND ADD IN LIEU THEREOF ONE (1.00) ASSISTANT TO THE FIRE CHIEF (PERSONNEL MANAGER) POSITION; EXEMPTING SAID ASSISTANT TO THE FIRE CHIEF FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that for better organizational effectiveness, the establishment of a Personnel Manager position is warranted; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the responsibilities for managing the day to day activities of the Personnel Division, the Personnel Manager will supervise the Equal Employment Opportunity functions within the Department and administer the Worker's Compensation program within the Department.

WHEREAS, this position is in lieu of a Battalion Chief which is presently authorized, thereby keeping overall authorized personnel unchanged; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Manager will have significant management level responsibilities which fall within the managerial definition contained in Charter section 117(a)17 and which justifies exemption from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that

"managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the classified service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on August 2, 1990 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, this action will amend the Appropriation Ordinance to substitute the new position in the budget and exempt it from the classified service and establish a salary rate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17504 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17504-1, as amended and adopted therein, by amending the personnel authorization of the Fire Department (120), to delete one (1.00) Battalion Chief position and adding in lieu thereof one (1.00) Assistant to the Fire Chief (Personnel Manager) position.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on August 2, 1990, the new Assistant to the Fire Chief (Personnel Manager) position in the

Fire Department (120), be and it is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position recited in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.7, 7.8 and 7.9 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 0-17468 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

SUBJECT: Exemption of the Fire Personnel Manager Position from the

Classified Service

On August 2, 1990, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Fire Department to exempt a Personnel Manager position from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities performed, the Commission finds that this position meets the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
