AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6,
DIVISION 8, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTIONS 26.0802 AND 26.0803
RELATING TO CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD ON
POLICE/COMMUNITY RELATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, Division 8, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 26.0802 and 26.0803 to read as follows.

**SEC. 26.0802 Citizens Advisory Board
 on Police/Community
 Relations Established**

A. There is hereby created a Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations consisting of fifteen (15) members who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve for a two-year term and each member shall serve until his or her successor is duly appointed and qualified. The expiration date of all terms shall be January 1. During January of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall on or after February 15, select a chairperson from among their members. The members shall be appointed in such

a manner so that the terms of not more than eight (8) members shall expire in any year. Any member missing three (3) or more consecutive meetings shall forfeit membership on the Board unless good and valid reasons for such absences are presented to and approved by the Council.

SEC. 26.0803 Duties and Functions

The Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations shall:


A. Adopt by a two-thirds vote of its members, by-laws governing the conduct of its meetings and activities, the establishment of subcommittees, and such other rules as may be necessary for the performance of its functions; provided that such by-laws shall specify that a quorum shall at all times consist of at least eight (8) members and that any amendment to the by-laws shall require an affirmative vote of two-thirds of its members.

B. through J. [No Change.]

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This ordinance amends Chapter II, Article 6, Division 8, of the San Diego Municipal Code relating to Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations by increasing the membership from fourteen (14) to fifteen (15) members, requiring that the terms of not more than eight (8) members shall expire in any one year, and raising the number of members for a quorum from seven (7) to eight (8).
