ADOPTED ON NOV 13 1990

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17504 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17504-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY EXEMPTING ONE (1.00) DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION SCHEDULE OF THE WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT (700) CLEAN WATER PROGRAM (70711) TO REFLECT THE POSITION AS UNCLASSIFIED; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Clean Water Program for Greater San Diego is the largest, most complex and most costly project ever undertaken by the City; and

WHEREAS, projects within the purview of the division are currently estimated to cost in excess of \$3 billion and will provide the entire region with sewage treatment and water reclamation into the middle of the next century; and

WHEREAS, the Clean Water Program (previously the Special Projects Division) was removed from the Water Utilities Department and reports directly to the City Manger's office; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Director for Construction Management will be responsible for construction of all projects connected with the expansion and upgrade of the metropolitan sewerage system; and

WHEREAS, this position has significant management level responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager requested the position of Deputy Director for Construction Management in the Clean Water Program be exempted from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the classified service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on March 1, 1990 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, this action will amend the appropriate ordinance to exempt the Deputy Director for Construction Management position from the classified service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on March 1, 1990, the Deputy Director for Construction Management position in the Clean Water Program (70711) be and it is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17504 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17504-1, as amended and adopted therein, by amending the personnel authorization of the Clean Water Program (70711) to reflect the exemption of the Deputy Director for Construction Management from the classified service and placement in the unclassified service.


Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position recited in sections 1 and 2 hereof, funds appropriated and available therefor in the Clean Water Program, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.7, 7.8, and 7.9 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-17468 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two public hearings, pursuant

to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the  
Charter of The City of San Diego.


