WHEREAS, the Police Department of The City of San Diego desires to participate in a project designated "Urban Street Gang Trafficking Enforcement Demonstration Project" for a period of one (1) year with funding provided by the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA); and

WHEREAS, this project will focus on developing an interagency response to the increasing number of young adult gang members who are perpetuating violence and participating in the sale, use, and distribution of drugs in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, this project will create a unit comprised of police and prosecutors for the purpose of eliminating gang violence and the current distribution of illicit narcotics in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, this project will develop intelligence information to be shared and used by law enforcement agencies countywide; and

WHEREAS, adult gang leaders presently on probation will be subjected to increased surveillance and will be targeted for enhanced investigation leading to arrest, conviction and incarceration; and

WHEREAS, there is no cost to The City of San Diego since the San Diego Police Department will provide two (2) Police Officer II/Detectives to participate and the County of San Diego will reimburse The City of San Diego for salaries, wages and fringe benefits amounting to ninety-one thousand and eight hundred

eighty-two dollars (\$91,882.00) for the services of the two (2)
Police Officer II/Detectives for one (1) year; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to execute an operational agreement for participation in the Urban Street Gang Trafficking Enforcement Demonstration Project for participating San Diego agencies, to be administered by the District Attorney of the County of San Diego, the pertinent parts of which are set forth in Document No. RR $\frac{274936}{1000}$, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is further authorized to accept the grant funds and expend the same for the above purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego shall comply with all provisions required for said project, including any amendment thereof, under the Urban Street Gang Drug Trafficking Enforcement Project and the rules and regulations of the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance.
