Marsha Lorraine	Police	\$464.94	Ms. Lorraine was a Clerical Assistant II in the Juvenile Administration section of the Police Department at the time she submitted her suggestion to prepare the Juvenile Missing Persons Log on the 8100 word processor, instead of manually typing it. Implementation of this suggestion is expected to save \$3,099.97 during the first year. This is a partial award, pending a 12-month review.
Robert Mackey	Utilities	\$320.00	Mr. Mackey is a Welder in the Systems Division of the Water Utilities Department. He suggested having the street name and number arc welded on vault covers (rather than being painted on) for positive identification. Although savings are difficult to identify, this is considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Patricia Trone	Police	\$160.00	Ms. Trone is a Clerical Assistant II in the Fiscal Management section of the Police Department. She suggested revising Form PD 478 to include designation of "Estimated Total Cost," which saves time in processing purchasing requests. Although savings are difficult to identify, this is considered to be a noticeable operational improvement.
Bernard Sepulvado	Police	\$160.00	Mr. Sepulvado is a Dispatcher II in Police Communications. He suggested that certain transfer lines be designated for bilingual calls, which now provides more efficient service to bilingual callers. Although savings are difficult to identify, this is considered to be a noticeable operational improvement.
