BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to create a Storm Drains Revenue Fund in order to collect such storm drain fees and to expend such revenues solely to: 1) reimburse the General Fund for costs associated with storm drain main maintenance; 2) reimburse the Water Utilities Enterprise Fund (No. 41506) for costs associated with collection and administration of the program and provide cash advances to the program; and 3) provide cash advances from the Water Utilities Enterprise Fund (No. 41506) as may be required subject to reimbursement from the Storm Drain Fund.
