

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-275226

ADOPTED ON MAR 07 1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 5, 1990, WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council held on MAR 07 1990, the Council indicated its intention to submit to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego one proposition relating to amending the Charter of The City of San Diego by amending Charter sections 4 and 12, one proposition amending the Charter of The City of San Diego by amending Charter section 5, one proposition adopting an ordinance changing the appropriations limit for the Fiscal Years 1992 through 1995, and one proposition to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness by the City for certain municipal improvements at a special municipal election to be held in the City on June 5, 1990; and

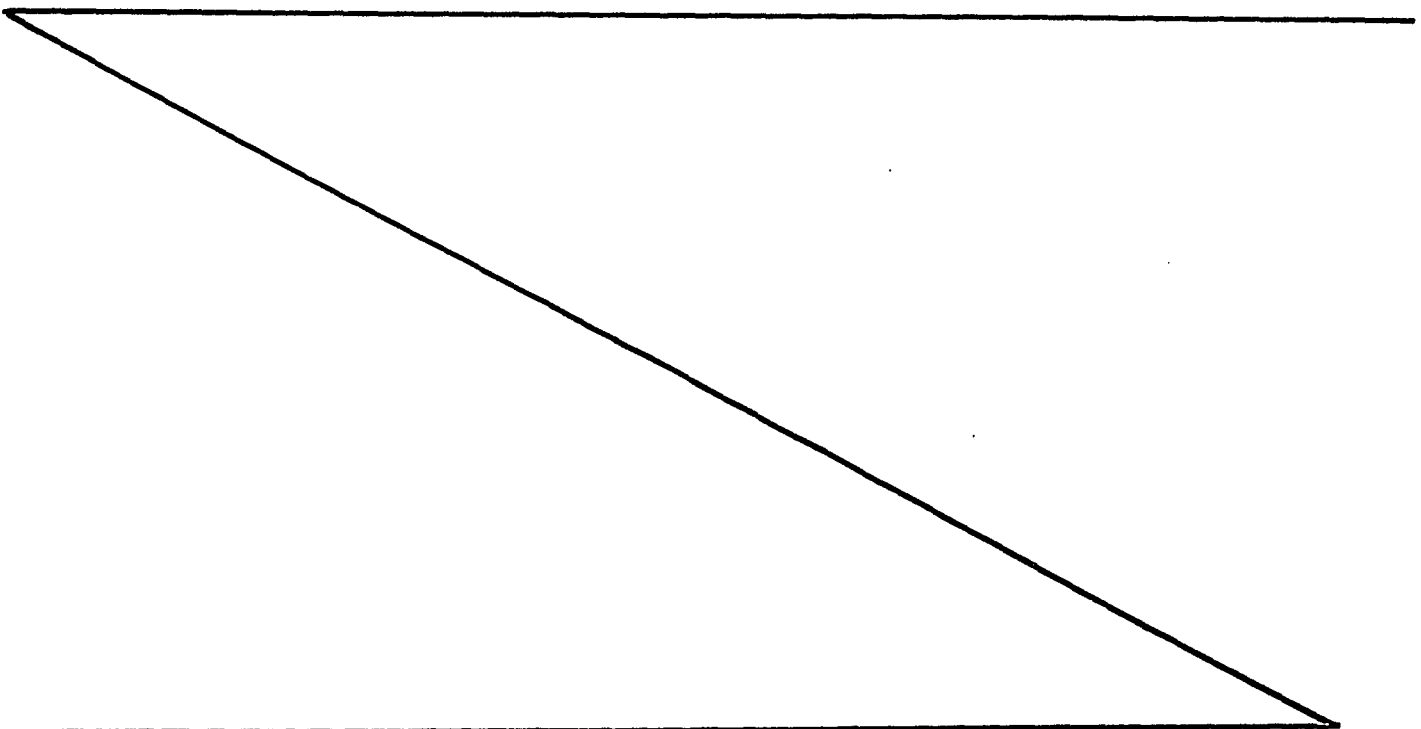
WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the statewide primary election to be held on the same date and that within the City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and that this special municipal election and the statewide primary election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has adopted an ordinance calling for a special municipal election and consolidating it with the statewide primary election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on June 5, 1990 with the statewide primary election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of amending the Charter of The City of San Diego.

2. The exact form of the propositions to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as they are to appear on the ballot is as follows:

PROPOSITION \_\_\_\_ . AN ORDINANCE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHANGING THE APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEARS 1992 THROUGH 1995.

Shall The City of San Diego's appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 1992 provided for in Article XIII B of the California Constitution be revised upward to \$592,000,000 (an increase of \$273 million) provided this limit is adjusted each year for Fiscal Years 1992-93, 1993-94 and 1994-95 for changes in population and cost of living as provided by the State Constitution to permit the expenditure of anticipated revenues from existing sources and sources to be authorized to fund needed programs which include, but are not necessarily limited to, police protection, fire protection, refuse collection and disposal, library services, park and recreation programs, and facility and infrastructure maintenance and capital improvements?

 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS AND  
 DISPATCH FACILITIES BONDS.

Shall The City of San Diego incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of \$25,500,000 for the purpose of replacing outdated and overloaded Police and Fire Department and other Public Safety Communications Facilities including, but not limited to, construction of Police and Fire and other Public Safety Communications Centers and equipment for such centers; a Police Department and Fire Department and other Public Safety computer-aided dispatch system and radio system; and related facilities as necessary to improve the efficiency of 911 emergency phone system and emergency radio systems resulting in reduced Police and Fire Department and other Public Safety response times, and for the payment of all costs and expenses in connection with such replacements and the issuance of such bonds?

The propositions shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of each measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

3. That the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.

4. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide primary election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.

5. That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of San Diego shall be reimbursed in full for the services performed by the Registrar of Voters for the City of San Diego in connection with the election services herein described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego agrees to indemnify and to save free and harmless the County, its officers,

agents and employees from expense or liability, including reasonable attorneys fees, as the result of an election contest initiated pursuant to the provisions of Division 13 of the Elections Code of the State of California after conduct of these elections.
