

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 275286

ADOPTED ON MAR 19 1990

WHEREAS, the United States Census has served for almost 200 years as a report on America, documenting our social, commercial and population movements as a nation; and

WHEREAS, SANDAG's 1990 Census Regional Complete Count Committee was formed to provide information that will help the Census Bureau reach everyone and promote the census to residents, businesses, and community groups; and

WHEREAS, during the 1980 Census, it is reported that 99% of all whites had been counted but African Americans, as well as Hispanics, were disproportionately undercounted; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that every individual not counted costs local jurisdictions \$153 annually in funding from the federal government; and

WHEREAS, the information collected about individuals is confidential and will not be released by the Census Bureau to any other governmental agency or the public; and


WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the State of California will gain an estimated seven seats in the House of Representatives when and if an accurate census count is taken; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council supports the United States Census Bureau's effort to count every resident of the City, without regard to citizenship status or legal residency and applauds the efforts of SANDAG's 1990 Census Regional Complete Count Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council endorses a public information campaign by The City of San Diego to promote the inclusion of every individual, with emphasis on the reportedly undercounted African-American and Latino populations and the emerging Asian, Filipino, homeless and migrant populations in the 1990 Census.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego urges Congress to require the Census Bureau to make such corrections of any undercount as is necessary to ensure an accurate and equitable compilation of census figures.
