SCHEDULE OF REFUSE DISPOSAL FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991

AUTHORITY-The following Refuse Disposal Fees have been established in accordance with the City of San Diego Municipal Code, Chapter IV, Article 6, Sections 66.0123, 66.0125 and 66.0126 and approved by Council Resolution R 275312 of MAR 19 1990.

1. STANDARD DISPOSAL FEE

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1990, the standard fee for the disposal of residential, commercial, and/or industrial waste in the City of San Diego's Miramar Landfill will be \$18.00 per ton. The fee for the disposal of clean, compostable green materials (yard wastes) will be \$15.25 per ton.

Fees shall be collected based upon the actual weight of waste delivered. However, if actual weights are not available, the flat rate fees described herein will be applicable. All commercial vehicles using the City landfill on a regular basis, must submit a certified tare weight for such vehicles.

2. FLAT RATE DISPOSAL FEES

In the event that the net weight of materials being disposed of can not be accurately determined, the following flat rate fees shall be assessed. The decision whether to charge by weight or flat rate shall be at the sole discretion of the City.

A. REFUSE COLLECTION VEHICLES (MECHANICAL PACKERS)

All mechanical packers will charged \$18.00 per ton for the actual net payload of the vehicle. In the event the scales or computerized registers are not operable, FEES WILL BE CHARGED BASED ON THE CALCULATED LEGAL NET PAYLOAD FOR EACH LICENSED PACKER UNDER THE ESTABLISHED STATE OF CALIFORNIA WEIGHT LIMITS. The legal net payload and flat rate fee will calculated for each packer truck licensed in the City at the time the vehicle is licensed.

3. SPECIAL HANDLING FEES

Additional charges shall be assessed on all wastes that require special attention, needs to be observed during disposal or presents difficulty in handling during disposal operations. Such items include, but are not limited to, dead animals, loads containing steel wire or springs such as mattresses and car seats, portions of boats, auto or truck bodies, straw or similar materials, and loads of large (1 cubic foot or more) dense items. Special handling charges shall be \$15.00 for passenger cars, pick-ups and small trailers, and \$30.00 for larger vehicles, except for the following specific items:
