

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE COLLIER AVENUE WEST OF WINONA AVENUE, AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING THEREOF.
BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:
1. That the public interest and convenience of said City may require the vacation of Collier Avenue hereinafter mentioned.
2. That it is the intention of said Council to order the vacation of Collier Avenue west of Winona Avenue, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17603-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-275535.
3. That this Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law."
4. The Council hereby fixes 2:00 p.m. on the 29th day of May, 1990 in the Council Chambers of the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Charles C. Dall Concourse, 202 "C" Street, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.
5. That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designed as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.


