RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 275700

ADOPTED ON MAY 14 1990

WHEREAS, cerebral palsy is the nation's most prevalent of all lifelong diseases disabling more than 700,000 individuals; and

WHEREAS, cerebral palsy cannot be cured, but persons with cerebral palsy can reach their full potential through therapy, training, counseling, medical assistance, and other services; and

WHEREAS, United Cerebral Palsy Associations, Inc., coordinates a nationwide network of 225 United Cerebral Palsy organizations (UCP affiliates); and


WHEREAS, the state and local UCP affiliates provide services for persons disabled with cerebral palsy and to their families, conduct public and professional educational programs, and support research in the prevention and management of cerebral palsy; and

WHEREAS, approximately 500 board members, volunteers, and staff, from UCP affiliates across the country are in San Diego attending the United Cerebral Palsy Association National Conference, "Building a Heritage of Excellence;" NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of all the citizens of San Diego, does hereby recognize and commend the dedication and achievements of the United Cerebral Palsy Association and its affiliates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that May 16 through 19, 1990 be and the same is hereby designated as "UNITED CEREBRAL PALSY DAYS" in San Diego.
