to determine if a redevelopment project or projects is feasible,


and that the City Manager is hereby authorized to conduct this feasibility study.

NORTH PARK REDEVELOPMENT SURVEY AREA

BOUNDARIES

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of Interstate Freeway 805 and a point 200 feet north of the centerline of Adams Avenue, westerly following a line 200 feet north of the centerline of Adams Avenue to the centerline of Texas Street; then southerly following the centerline of Texas Street to its intersection with the centerline of Mission Avenue; then southwesterly following the centerline of Mission Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Shirley Ann Place; then southerly following the centerline of Shirley Ann Place and the alleys between Louisiana Street and Texas Street to the centerline of the alley immediately north of the parcels fronting the north side of El Cajon Boulevard; then westerly to the centerline of Park Boulevard; then southerly following the centerline of Park Boulevard to the centerline of the east/west alley immediately south of parcels fronting on the south side of El Cajon Boulevard; then westerly to the centerline of the alley running north/south between Florida Street and Georgia Street; then southerly, following the alley centerline, to the centerline of University Avenue; then easterly to the centerline of Florida Street; then southerly, following the centerline of Florida Street to the centerline of Myrtle Avenue; then easterly to the centerline of the alley running north/south between Florida Street and Alabama Street; then northerly, following the alley centerline, to the centerline of University Avenue, then easterly to the centerline of Alabama Street; then southerly following the centerline of Alabama Street, to the centerline of Landis Street; then easterly, following the centerline of Landis Street, to an intersection with an extension of the property line at which parcels fronting on the east side of Louisiana and the west side of Texas Street meet; then southerly to point intersecting the line which extends through the centerline of Landis Street between 28th Street and Ray Street; then easterly to an intersection with an extension of the property line at which parcels fronting on the east side of 29th Street and the west side of 30th Street meet; then southerly, following the property line, to the centerline of Upas Street; then easterly to the centerline of the alley running north/south between Dale Street and 30th Street; then southerly, following the alley centerline, to an extension of the centerline of Olive Street; then easterly to the centerline of the alley running north/south immediately east of parcels fronting on the east side of 30th Street; then northerly, following the alley centerline, to the centerline of Upas Street; then westerly to an intersection with an extension of the property line at which parcels fronting on the east side of 30th Street and west side of Ray Street meet; then northerly, following the property line, to the centerline of Landis Street; then easterly to the point at which the centerline of Boundary Street and the centerline of Landis Street between Boundary Street and Nile Street intersect; then easterly, following the centerline of Boundary Street, to the centerline of Interstate Freeway 805; the northwesterly, following the centerline of Interstate Freeway 805 to the point of origin.
