DESCRIPTION OF MAINTENANCE

The proposed landscape maintenance consists in general of the

 e. Replacement of dead or diseased trees and shrubs
 f. Repair of facilities
 The maintenance shall be for a period of one year, terminating on

June 30, 1991.

Section 2

DESCRIPTION OF MAINTENANCE DISTRICT

The expenses of the contemplated maintenance hereinbefore mentioned are made chargeable upon the district hereinafter described and the Council does declare said district to be the district benefited by the maintenance and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof. The district is described as follows:

All that real property in said City of San Diego included within the exterior boundary lines of the map designated as the "Eastgate Technology Park Landscape Maintenance District" consisting of one (1) page and filled in the office of the City Clerk under Document No. M-216-1, excepting therefrom all public streets, public lands, roads, alleys, avenues and highways. Reference is hereby made to the map for a further full and more particular description of the maintenance district on the map, so on file, shall govern for all details as to the extent of the maintenance district.

It is proposed to assess the total amount of maintenance costs of the district, plus the incidental expenses thereto, less a City contribution of \$3,438 for median maintenance and open space lands to be maintained, to all the real property within the district in conformance with the provisions of the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975 and in proportion to the estimated benefits from the maintenance to be received by the individual parcel of real property.
