RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 275883

ADOPTED ON JUN 11 1990

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is interested in pursuing the concept of a regional airport to accommodate San Diego's long term airport needs; and

WHEREAS, the Public Facilities and Recreation Committee reviewed the concept of a "wayport" which would be outside the City but would be accessed through a rapid transit facility; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Intergovernmental Relations Department is hereby directed to review and to bring back to the Council for consideration, a report on the status of the Wayport Development Act of 1989 and the Federal Maglev Initiative started in 1990, together with a draft resolution supporting such Initiative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby adopts the following resolution proposed by Councilmember Bob Filner:

WHEREAS, San Diego is now the sixth largest city in the nation; and

WHEREAS, rapid growth has tremendously increased San Diego's airport needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego and various other agencies have been trying unsuccessfully for over two decades to develop an alternative airport proposal; and

WHEREAS, alternatives currently being studied by SANDAG

are again unlikely to produce a feasible solution to San Diego's airport needs because of political and technical constraints; and

WHEREAS, Lindbergh Field cannot accommodate San Diego's long term airport needs, but can be improved and expanded to accommodate commercial passenger activity for the next 20-25 years; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has not conducted comprehensive conversations with the United States Navy and Marine Corps regarding the existing and future use of all Navy-owned properties in Southern California, including North Island, Ream Field, Miramar Naval Air Station, Camp Pendleton, and the Marine Corps Recruit Depot; and

WHEREAS, new and innovative technologies have not been adequately considered in San Diego's search for a regional airport solution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby endorse a three-point program to solve San Diego's future airport needs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this program includes:


- (1) requesting that the Port District immediately implement its action plan to upgrade the capacity and safety of Lindbergh Field to meet projected needs to the year 2010,
- (2) directing the City Manager to recommend to the City Council a process and calendar for a thorough examination of new and creative airport technologies and the feasibility of privatization, and
- (3) directing the City Manager to begin

comprehensive discussions with the Navy and Marine Corps regarding the use of Navy and Marine lands in Southern California which they determine may no longer be necessary for military purposes, to help solve San Diego's air traffic needs for the 21st century.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council recognizes that continued use of NAS/Miramar by the U.S. Navy will be necessary until such time as the Navy determines that the Naval Air Station will no longer be used for military purposes and manifests its intent to abandon further studies of NAS/Miramar for either domestic or joint use with the Navy.
