following: I. River Channel

- a. Revegetation and wildlife monitoring and reporting as required by State and Federal permits issued in conjunction with the FSDRIP
- Dredging as indicated by river bottom soundings conducted a minium of once every five (5) years.

  c. General landscape maintenance, monitoring and revegetation as needed.

  d. Maintenance and repair or irrigation facilities as needed.

- e. Restorative work in the event of bank washout, erosion or shoating effecting the channel, the river-islands or the buffer zone.

  f. Trash and debris clean up blweekly.

- 11. BufferZone
- a. General landscape maintenance, monitoring and revegetation as needed.
- b. Maintenance and repair of irrigation facilities as needed.
- c. Trash and litter control two (2) times per week.
  d. Maintenance of picnic tables, benches and trash receptacles as

The maintenance shall be for a period of one year, terminating on June 30, 1991.
