WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego ("Council") desires to initiate proceedings for the designation of a facilities benefit assessment area of benefit in Mira Mesa pursuant to Ordinance No. 0-15318 (New Series) of the Council ("Ordinance") which area of benefit will specially benefit from the acquisition, improvements and construction of certain public improvements more particularly described in Part 1 of the Report referred to in these recitais ("Public Facilities Financing Plan"); and

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Section 5. The boundaries of the facilitis userelit assessment area of benefit will be as set forth in the Report.

Section 6. The method pursuant to which the cost of the public facilities project is to be apportioned among the parcels within the facilities benefit assessment area of benefit and the amount of the facilities benefit assessments which will be charged to each such parcel will be as set forth in the Report.

Section 7. The Council hereby determines it necessary to provide for automatic increases in the amount of facilities benefit assessments for landowners who have not paid their facilities benefit assessments of or landowners who have not paid their facilities benefit assessments without the necessity for further proceeding pursuant to Section 61.2212 of the Ordinance in order to reflect increases in the cost of money during the period between the imposition of the facilities benefit assessments and completition of the public facilities projects.
