RESOLUTION NUMBER R-276020

ADOPTED ON JUN 28 1990

WHEREAS, it has been proposed that the IRD function be combined with the Committee Consultant element of the Council Administration Program (02900); and

WHEREAS, concurrent therewith, it is proposed to transfer IRD funds to the new program so that the personnel and nonpersonnel expenses of the operation may be accommodated; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated, conceptually, that the new organization may be a City department; and

WHEREAS, Council will discuss the matter in greater depth and, upon consideration, will determine which form of program organization may be warranted; and

WHEREAS, it is further desired that there be designated a chief director of said effort who is nominated by the Mayor, confirmed by the Council and subject to removal by a majority of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council hereby declares its intent to create a new Legislative Services Department within City government by combining the Intergovernmental Relations Department and the Council Committee element of the Council Administration program and the funds associated therewith.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intent of Council to appoint Judith L. Bauer, as chief director of the new department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney be and he is hereby requested to take all necessary action to promulgate ordinances amending the San Diego Municipal Code and the annual appropriations ordinance, as necessary, to effectuate the final decision of Council in respect to this reorganization of legislative services support.
