The expenses of the contemplated maintenance hereinbefore mentioned are made chargeable upon the district hereinafter described and the Council does declare said district to be the district benefitted by the maintenance and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof. All that real property in said City of San Diego included within the exterior; boundary lines of the map designated as the "Mid-City Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District" consisting of eight (8) pages and filled in the office of the City Clerk under Document No. M-217-1, excepting therefrom all public streets, public lands, roads, sileys, evenues and highways. Reference is hereby made to the map for a further full and more particular description of the maintenance district on the map, so on file, shall govern for all details as to the extent of the maintenance district.

ASSESSMENT OF COST AND EXPENSE
