RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 5, 1990.

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, June 5, 1990, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-17438 (New Series), adopted March 7, 1990, which special Municipal Election was called for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of The City of San Diego (3) proposisitions: One proposition to amend Section 4 and 12 of the Charter of The City of San Diego pertaining to the number of Council districts (Proposition 8); one proposition to amend Section 5 of the Charter of The City of San Diego to establish a one-time waiver of the four-year limit on redistricting (Proposition C); and, an ordinance changing the appropriations limit for fiscal years 1992 through 1995 (Proposition D), as follows:
