RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 5, 1990.

WHEREAS, a special municipal bond election was held in The City of San Diego on Tuesday, June 5, 1990, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-17439 (New Series), adopted March 7, 1990, which Special Municipal Bond Election was called for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of The City of San Diego a general obligation bond proposition for the acquisition and construction of Police and Fire Department and other Public Safety Communications and Dispatch Facilities as follows:

Safety response times, and for the payment of all costs and expenses in connection with such replacements and the issuance of such bonds?

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the of Registrar of
Voters of San Diego County canvassing the returns of the special
municipal election, as certified to the City Clerk, has been duly
received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of these elections has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

The whole number of votes cast in the City was 201,379.

ΙI

The number of votes cast in the City for and against said bond proposition which appeared on the ballot as Proposition E and the total number of votes cast upon said proposition is as follows:

PROPOSITION E

For 121,203

Against 56,060

TOTAL 177,263

Proposition E received the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the qualified voters voting on such proposition and is hereby declared to have been approved.

The number of votes in each precinct cast for and against each measure is recorded in the Election Returns Book, which book is a part of the records of this Council.

The City Clerk shall make public the results of the canvass of the special municipal election by publication of a copy of this resolution.
