WHEREAS, the Acting Director of Intergovernmental Relations of The City of San Diego has prepared Report IRD #90-23 which identifies a proposed redevelopment project known as the Barrio Logan Pacific Rim Center Redevelopment Project in The City of San Diego located in the following area:

That area generally bounded by Commercial Street to the North, Harbor Drive to the South West, Crosby Street to the South, and Interstate 5 to the South East, and including the Bay Park Pier Areas; and

WHEREAS, the Barrio Logan Pacific Rim Redevelopment Project may consist of any one or more of the facilities in the areas identified in the report; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conceptually approves of the project as outlined in the report and identified herein, reserving the right however, to take separate and specific approval action as to each facility or project use therein, subject to appropriate environmental compliance and planning review; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council hereby supports and requests an amendment of Section 1317(6) of the Tax Reform Act of 1986, to include a provision to read as follows:

(AA) a mixed use redevelopment project located in one or more of the San Diego Enterprise Zone, Centre City East Planned District, or the Barrio Logan Pacific Rim Center Redevelopment Project area as identified by the Council of The City of San Diego in Resolution No. R- 276249 All such facilities shall be deemed redevelopment activities within the meaning of this subsection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby supports and requests an amendment to Section 1317 of the Tax Reform Act of 1986 to include a provision to read as follows:

Section 146 of the 1986 Code shall not apply to up to a maximum of \$306,395,000 of private activity bonds (within the meaning of Section 146) designated by The City of San Diego, California, and issued on or before December 31, [1993] or by on on behalf of the State of California, or any of its political subdivisions, to finance:

- (a) mass commuting facilities, facilities for the furnishing of water, sewage facilities, qualified hazardous waste facilities, or solid waste disposal facilities located in San Diego County, California;
- (b) other exempt facilities listed in Section 142(a) or other facilities listed in Section 144(a), and located in the San Diego Enterprise Zone or the San Diego Centre City East Planned District; or
- (c) any other facilities described in Section 1317(6)(AA).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Acting Director of the Intergovernmental Relations Department is authorized and directed
