MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1.


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to initiate proceedings for the annexation of certain properties described in the Report of the City Engineer on the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1, pursuant to the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 (Sections 22500, et seq., Streets and Highways Code) and the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975 (Sections 65.0201, et seq., San Diego Municipal Code). The annexations will be reflected in the revised maps for the district.

2. That the notice to all parties affected by this annexation is within the provisions of Section 65.0210 of the San Diego Municipal Code.
