A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CERTIFYING THE SECONDARY STUDY OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS WITH RESPECT TO THE PROPOSED DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND PACIFIC SCENE/PATRICK DEVELOPMENT AND THE V. GORDON GROUP, AND THE PROPOSED SALE OF REAL PROPERTY AND CONSTRUCTION OF MIXED USES, INCLUDING RESIDENTIAL, INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL/RETAIL STRUCTURES PURSUANT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Southcrest Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the following environmental document has been prepared in connection with and subsequent to the approval and adoption of the Project:

1. Environmental Impact Report for the Southcrest Redevelopment Plan (EQD No. 83-0770); the Southcrest Redevelopment Plan was approved by the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") on April 14, 1986, by Ordinance No. 0-16622, that the information in the Environmental Impact Report on the Southcrest Redevelopment Plan was approved by the Redevelopment Agency on February 12, 1985 by Resolution No. 1054; and

WHEREAS, the Council proposes to approve a Disposition and Development Agreement with Pacific Scene/Patrick Development and The V. Gordon Group (the "Developer") pursuant to which: The Agency shall sell cleared real properties to the Developer for the development and construction by the Developer of mixed uses, including residential, industrial and commercial/retail structures; and

WHEREAS, the sale of real property pursuant to the Disposition and Development Agreement and the construction of the development pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Disposition and Development Agreement and the Southcrest Redevelopment Plan is one of the redevelopment activities assessed by the Environmental Impact Report for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Southast Economic Development Corporation,
Inc., acting on behalf of the Agency, has prepared a Secondary
Study in accordance with and pursuant to the California
Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA) and State and local
regulations and guidelines adopted pursuant thereto and such
Secondary Study assesses the environmental impacts of the sale of
real property and construction of structures pursuant to the
Disposition and Development Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Council hereby certifies that the Secondary Study of environmental impacts with respect to the proposed sale of real property and the construction of mixed uses, including residential, industrial and commercial/retail structures pursuant

to the Disposition and Development Agreement has been prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA) and State and local regulations and guidelines adopted pursuant thereto, and the Agency has certified said Secondary Study.

- 2. The Council hereby further certifies that the information contained in the Secondary Study and the Environmental Impact Report for the Project has been reviewed and considered by the members of the Council.
  - 3. The Council hereby finds and determines that:
  - (a) No substantial changes are proposed in the Project, or with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is to be undertaken, as a result of the sale of real property and construction of the development pursuant to the Disposition and Development Agreement, which will require important revisions in the Environmental Impact Report certified for the Project, due to the involvement of new significant environmental impacts not covered in the Environmental Impact Report; and
  - (b) No new information of substantial importance to the Project has become available which was not known or could not have been known at the time the Environmental Impact Report for the Project were certified as complete, and which shows that the Project will have any significant effects not discussed previously in the Environmental Impact Report, or that any significant effects previously examined will be substantially more severe than shown in the

Environmental Impact Report, or that any mitigation measures or alternatives previously found not to be feasible or not previously considered would substantially reduce or lessen any significant effects of the Project on the environment; and

- (c) No environmental impact report is necessary or required; and
- (d) The sale of real property and construction of structures pursuant to the Disposition and Development Agreement will have no significant effect on the environment except as identified and considered in the Environmental Impact Report.
- 4. The Council hereby finds and determines that the certifications, findings and determinations with respect to environmental impacts in the Project as set forth in Ordinance No. O-16622 of the Council include as an implementation activity the sale of property and construction of the development pursuant to the Disposition and Development Agreement and such certifications, findings and determinations are hereby ratified in their entirety.
