BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds that project revisions now mitigated potentially significant effects on the environment previously identified in the Initial Study and therefore, that said Mitigated Negative Declaration, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved.

EXHIBIT A MITIGATION MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM (LA PENSIONE DEP NO. 90-0241)

Cultural/Scientific Resources

In order to mitigate the loss of a designated historic structure, the project shall replicate the existing eastern and southern façades of the Bernardini Building into the proposed project. Prior to the issuance of building and demolition permits, the plans shall be reviewed by the City Architect's Office and Environmental Analysis Section of the Planning Department to assure that La Pensione's façade is consistent with the San Diego Historical Site Board's action in approving demolition of a designated historic structure and replicating its façade into the redevelopment project.

Noise

The project site may be adversely impacted by future noise levels of 69 db(A) due to an average daily traffic volume (ADT) of 9,800 on India Street for the year 2005 and by present noise levels of 67 db(A) by present Lindbergh Field aircraft traffic; the combined noise levels would be 70 db(A). The applicant has agreed to the following measures which shall be made conditions of the Centre City Overlay Zone Permit:

- 1. An acoustical engineering study, based on <u>future</u> vehicular traffic volume and <u>present</u> aircraft traffic, would be required prior to the issuance of building permits to determine the appropriate design and upgraded building materials needed to comply with the California Administration Code, Title 24 residential/hotel interior noise requirement of 45 db(A) CNEL.
- 2. One copy of a revised acoustical analysis based on <u>future</u> vehicular traffic volumes and <u>present</u> aircraft traffic shall be submitted to the Planning Department's Environmental Analysis Section for review.
- 3. Prior to the issuance of demolition and building permits, the Environmental Analysis Section shall review building plans to ensure that the above measures have been incorporated into the project specifications. In addition, Noise Abatement staff shall determine if the noise attenuating measures are in conformance with the approved plans.

Upon completion of the identified measures into the design of the proposed project, potential noise impacts would be reduced to below a level of significance.
